Family Guide Exodus 19-20 (The Ten Commandments)

For Kids (Ages 6-12):

- 1. What do you think it was like for the people of Israel to camp at the foot of the mountain for days? Can you imagine what they saw and heard?
- 2. God told Moses to tell the people to be ready and consecrated. What do you think it means to be ready for something important?
- 3. What are some rules or guidelines that you think are really important for us to follow in our family? Why are they important?
- 4. Let's talk about the first commandment, "You shall have no other gods before me." What does it mean to have God as our number one priority in our lives?
- 5. Do you think it's easy or hard to keep all of God's commandments? Why?

For Teenagers (Ages 13-18):

- 1. Exodus 19 talks about how God came down in smoke and fire on Mount Sinai. Why do you think God chose to reveal Himself this way to the Israelites?
- 2. In Exodus 20, we find the Ten Commandments. Which one(s) do you find the most challenging to follow in your life? Why?
- 3. How do you think the Ten Commandments apply to our lives today? Can you give examples of situations where they are relevant?
- 4. The fifth commandment says to honor your parents. What does honoring your parents look like in your daily life, especially as a teenager?
- 5. Discuss the idea of not coveting in the tenth commandment. How can the desire for what others have affect our happiness and relationships?
